- The most recent jobs report was the worst we've seen in years.
- Every American out of work faces a personal crisis, for themselves and their family. That's why House Republicans remain focused on creating jobs and growing the economy.
- Dozens of House-passed jobs bills remain stuck in the Democratic-run Senate awaiting action, including the *SKILLS Act* which helps the long-term unemployed get training they need to re-enter the workforce.

- House Republicans want to get Washington out of the way so our economy can grow and more Americans can get back to work.

Topline Messaging on Obamacare

- On top of a struggling economy, Obamacare is forcing hardworking Americans to contend with skyrocketing health care costs, restricted access, and cancelled plans.
- The American people recognize this is a bad law – the latest enrollment numbers are nowhere close to the Administration's stated goals, which is why the White House has tried to fudge the numbers.
- Both Administration officials and outside experts have expressed concern over the lack of security on Obamacare exchange websites, which leaves taxpayers' personal information at risk.
- This week, the House voted to demand the Administration provide the people with regular reports on enrollment and other data, and to notify individuals if their personal information is breached through an Obamacare exchange.
- House Republicans remain committed to protecting the American people from effects of the President's deeply-flawed health care law.
